

Aloka G. Chakravarty, Ph.D.

Dr. Aloka Chakravarty is the Acting Director of the Office of Biostatistics in CDER, FDA.

Dr. Chakravarty joined CDER in 1992 and brings to her current position considerable experience in CDER. She is an internationally recognized thought leader in multi-regional clinical trials, safety evaluation, surrogate markers and biomarkers in drug development and has presented and published widely on it. Her research interests include MRCTs, surrogate endpoint methodology, biomarkers, interim analysis, meta-analysis, Bayesian methodology, safety evaluation and statistical computing. Dr. Chakravarty served as an Adjunct Faculty in Department of Statistics, Foundation for Advanced Education in the Sciences, National Institutes of Health.

Dr. Chakravarty has received numerous awards, including the FDA Award of Merit in 2008 and Dr. Frances O. Kelsey Drug Safety Excellence Award in 2012. Aloka received her Ph.D. in Statistics from Temple University, and M.Stat from Indian Statistical Institute. Dr. Chakravarty is a Fellow of the American Statistical Association and an Associate Editor of Statistics in Biomedical Research.
